

## **El Shaddai and Christ Crucified 01**

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### ***El Shaddai and The Covenant***

Genesis 17:17-19 (NKJV) 17 Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed<6711>, and said in his heart, “Shall a child be born to a man who is one hundred years old? And shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?” 18 And Abraham said to God, “Oh, that<3863> Ishmael might live before<H6440> You!” 19 Then God said: “No, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac<H3327>; I will establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965>/LXX{στήσω}<G2476> My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his descendants<H2233> after him.

Genesis 17:20-22 (NKJV) 20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard you. Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall beget twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation. 21 But My covenant I will establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965>/LXX{στήσω}<G2476> with Isaac<H3327>, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time next year.” 22 Then He finished talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ <H6965> “Inflected Search” of term “establish” Gen. 17:9

Gen. 6:18 But I will establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> My covenant with you; and you shall go into the ark—you, your sons, your wife, and your sons’ wives with you.

Gen. 9:11 Thus I establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> My covenant with you: Never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.”

Gen. 9:17 And God said to Noah, “This is the sign of the covenant which I have established{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> between Me and all flesh that is on the earth.”

Gen. 17:7 And I will establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

Gen. 17:19 ¶ Then God said: “No, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; I will establish{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his descendants after him.

Gen. 26:3 Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> the oath which I swore to Abraham your father.

Exo. 6:4 I have also established{יְהַמְדֶּנּוּ}<H6965> My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers.

***(LXX1) Rahlfs Greek Septuagint:***

{στήσω}<G2476> “Inflected Search” of term “establish” Gen. 17:9

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Gen. 17:21 But My covenant I will establish{στήσω}<G2476> with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time next year.”

Gen. 26:3 Dwell in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your descendants I give all these lands, and I will perform{στήσω}<G2476> the oath which I swore to Abraham your father.

Gen. 43:9 I myself will be surety for him; from my hand you shall require him. If I do not bring him back to you and set{στήσω}<G2476> him before you, then let me bear the blame forever.
