Walk Perfect, The Covenant and Multiply

Genesis 17:1-4 (AV) 1 ¶ And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared<7200> to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty<7706> God; walk<1980> before<6440> me, and be thou perfect<8549>. 2 And I will make my covenant<1285> between<996> me and thee, and will multiply<7235> thee exceedingly.

Gen. 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just<6662> man and perfect<8549> in his generations, and Noah walked<1980> with God.

Gen. 17:1 ¶ And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk<1980> before me, and be thou perfect<8549>.

Psa. 15:2 He that walketh<1980> uprightly<8549>, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.

Psa. 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk<1980> uprightly<8549>.

Genesis 6:8-9 (AV) 8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. 9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just<6662>* man and perfect<8549> in his generations, and Noah walked<1980> with God.

The Covenant Established with A Person & His House

Genesis 6:18-19 (AV) 18 But with thee will I establish<6965> my covenant<1285>; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee. 19 And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female.

Genesis 7:1 (AV) 1 And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous<6662> before me in this generation.

Genesis 9:1 (AV) 1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply<7235>, and replenish the earth.

Christ was smitten once Exodus 17:1-7; Numbers 20:5-13

Genesis 9:7-17 (AV) 7 And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply<7235>; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply<7235> therein. 8 And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, 9 And I, behold, I establish<6965> my covenant<1285> with you, and with your seed after you; 10 And with every living creature that is with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth. 11 And I will establish<6965> my covenant<1285> with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. 12 And God said, This is the token of the covenant<1285> which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: 13 I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant<1285> between me and the earth. 14 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: 15 And I will remember my covenant<1285>, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. 16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant<1285> between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth. 17 And God said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant<1285>, which I have established between me and all flesh that is upon the earth.

From One Creation unto The New Creation

Genesis 7:16-18 (AV) 16 And they that went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God had commanded him: and the LORD shut him in. 17 And the flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth. 18 And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.

Genesis 7:23 (AV) 23 And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark.

Genesis 8:4 (AV) 4 And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.

Genesis 8:6-12 (AV) 6 And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: 7 And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. 8 Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground; 9 But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark. 10 And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark; 11 And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth was an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth. 12 And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.

Genesis 8:15-19 (AV) 15 And God spake unto Noah, saying, 16 Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee. 17 Bring forth with thee every living thing that is with thee, of all flesh, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply<7235> upon the earth. 18 And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him: 19 Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, and whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

Genesis 8:20-21 (AV) 20 And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. 21 And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

Noah and His House/Household entered into a New Creation. They had to begin to discover their Life anew in this New Creation. What they *believed* to be "their" lives came to an end in the previous creation. They were no longer in (nor part of) that Old Creation. Therefore they could no longer continue to find what they *believed* to be "their" lives in *that* creation that was brought to its end in the flood (it was no longer present). But they now had to begin to discover their true "Life" in this New Creation wherein their "Life" was found.

Galatians 6:14-16 (AV) 14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world. 15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature. 16 And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

Zechariah 9:9 (AV) 9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just<6662>, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

(Pulpit) The Pulpit Commentary: Malachi 3:17

Malachi 3:16-18 (AV) 16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. 17 And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. 18 Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous<6662> and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.

Malachi 4:1-3 (AV) 1 For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch. 2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. 3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts.
