(Murdock) And he said to me: Stand upon thy feet; for I have appeared to thee, for this purpose, to constitute thee a minister and a witness of this thy seeing me, and of thy seeing me hereafter.

-If our heart is NOT submitted unto The Knowledge of God, we will *think* that we have a “life” that is NOT Life , but it is only *our* concept. *Our* concept of Life  does not please God. 

1st Man Adam Fails God Miserably

Our concepts come from the 1st Man Adam with his natural/carnal/temporal Mind/Reason

One of the *First* things he does is eat of the tree of Death that God told him NOT to eat of.

Christ, our Life (Whom God knows) is the *only* One Who pleases Him.

Gen 2:15-17

Gen 3:1-7

Moses 40yrs in preparation in the desert for one thing before he began serving The Ministry of God The Appearing of The Lord. “Not I, but Christ” (Ex 3:12, 16-17; Ex 6:6; Ex 19:3-4)

Exodus 3:1-6 (NKJV) 1 Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. 2 And the Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. 3 Then Moses said, “I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn.” 4 So when the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.” 5 Then He said, “Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.” 6 Moreover He said, “I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.

Cities of Refuge

Deuteronomy 19:1-10 (NKJV) 1 “When the Lord your God has cut off the nations whose land the Lord your God is giving you, and you dispossess them and dwell in their cities and in their houses, 2 you shall separate three cities for yourself in the midst of your land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess. 3 You shall prepare roads for yourself, and divide into three parts the territory of your land which the Lord your God is giving you to inherit, that any manslayer may flee there. 4 “And this is the case of the manslayer who flees there, that he may live: Whoever kills his neighbor unintentionally, not having hated him in time past— 5 as when a man goes to the woods with his neighbor to cut timber, and his hand swings a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slips from the handle and strikes his neighbor so that he dies—he shall flee to one of these cities and live; 6 lest the avenger of blood, while his anger is hot, pursue the manslayer and overtake him, because the way is long, and kill him, though he was not deserving of death, since he had not hated the victim in time past. 7 Therefore I command you, saying, ‘You shall separate three cities for yourself.’ 8 “Now if the Lord your God enlarges your territory, as He swore to your fathers, and gives you the land which He promised to give to your fathers, 9 and if you keep all these commandments and do them, which I command you today, to love the Lord your God and to walk always in His ways, then you shall add three more cities for yourself besides these three, 10 lest innocent blood be shed in the midst of your land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, and thus guilt of bloodshed be upon you.

Numbers 35:9-15 (NKJV) 9 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 10 “Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: When you cross the Jordan into the land of Canaan, 11 then you shall appoint cities to be cities of refuge for you, that the manslayer who kills any person accidentally may flee there. 12 They shall be cities of refuge for you from the avenger, that the manslayer may not die until he stands before the congregation in judgment. 13 And of the cities which you give, you shall have six cities of refuge. 14 You shall appoint three cities on this side of the Jordan, and three cities you shall appoint in the land of Canaan, which will be cities of refuge. 15 These six cities shall be for refuge for the children of Israel, for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them, that anyone who kills a person accidentally may flee there.

Imperfect Man that NEVER pleases God was created on the 6th Day

The Cities of Refuge are in place for the people of God (and all who would come) who do what is NOT pleasing to God. Though The *only* One Who pleases God is present, and is their Life.

Our Salvation is NOT dependent upon what Man knows, but upon What/Who God knows. When the Holy Spirit makes us to know this, we will rejoice and give glory to our Lord.

The issue is NOT “us,” but Christ

The crossing of Jordan is a tremendous knowledge of Reality

Jordan: the heart *submitted* unto The Knowledge of God concerning what took place at the Red Sea

Joshua 20:1-9 (NKJV) 1 The Lord also spoke to Joshua, saying, 2 “Speak to the children of Israel, saying: Appoint for yourselves cities of refuge, of which I spoke to you through Moses, 3 that the slayer who kills a person accidentally or unintentionally may flee there; and they shall be your refuge from the avenger of blood. 4 And when he flees to one of those cities, and stands at the entrance of the gate of the city, and declares his case in the hearing of the elders of that city, they shall take him into the city as one of them, and give him a place, that he may dwell among them. 5 Then if the avenger of blood pursues him, they shall not deliver the slayer into his hand, because he struck his neighbor unintentionally, but did not hate him beforehand. 6 And he shall dwell in that city until he stands before the congregation for judgment, and until the death of the one who is high priest in those days. Then the slayer may return and come to his own city and his own house, to the city from which he fled.’ ” 7 So they appointed Kedesh in Galilee, in the mountains of Naphtali, Shechem in the mountains of Ephraim, and Kirjath Arba (which is Hebron) in the mountains of Judah. 8 And on the other side of the Jordan, by Jericho eastward, they assigned Bezer in the wilderness on the plain, from the tribe of Reuben, Ramoth in Gilead, from the tribe of Gad, and Golan in Bashan, from the tribe of Manasseh. 9 These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel and for the stranger who dwelt among them, that whoever killed a person accidentally might flee there, and not die by the hand of the avenger of blood until he stood before the congregation.

Cities of Refuge East of the Jordan

Deuteronomy 4:41-43 (NKJV) 41 Then Moses set apart three cities on this side of the Jordan, toward the rising of the sun, 42 that the manslayer might flee there, who kills his neighbor unintentionally, without having hated him in time past, and that by fleeing to one of these cities he might live: 43 Bezer in the wilderness on the plateau for the Reubenites, Ramoth in Gilead for the Gadites, and Golan in Bashan for the Manassites.

Gen 32:24-31

The Sun Rose on Jacob as he Crossed Peniel

He is *now* walking in The Light of The Knowledge of The Eternal Day —Who Christ IS

He is *now* walking in The Power and Ability of Another

He is *now* walking in a New Way with heart submitted unto “Not I, but Christ”

Before, he wanted “his” concept to be blessed by God
God will not bless “our” concepts, however “good” we think they are
His Son Who IS our Life is already blessed

Not “I,” but Israel

The heart submitted unto The Knowledge of God and therefore walking in Light

John 7:18 (GNT28) ὁ ἀφ' ἑαυτοῦ λαλῶν τὴν δόξαν τὴν ἰδίαν ζητεῖ· ὁ δὲ ζητῶν τὴν δόξαν τοῦ πέμφαντος αὐτὸν οὗτος ἀληθὴς ἐστὶν καὶ ἀδικία **ἐν αὐτῷ** οὐκ ἔστιν.

John 7:14-18 (NKJV) 14 Now about the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple and taught. 15 And the Jews marveled, saying, “How does this Man know letters, having never studied?” 16 Jesus answered them and said, “My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me. 17 If anyone wills to do His will, he shall know concerning the doctrine, whether it is from God or whether I speak on My own authority. 18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722><846>.
