Juan 14:20 (GNT28) **έν** εκείνη τη **ήμέρα γνώσεσθε** ύμεις ότι **έγώ έν τώ πατρί** μου και ύμεις **έν έμοι** κάγω **έν ύμίν**.

John 14:20 (NKJV) 20 At{έν}<1722> that day{ήμέρα}<2250> you will know{γνώσεσθε}<1097> that I{έγω}<1473> am in{έν}<1722> My Father, and you in Me{έν έμοι}<1722><1473>, and I in{έν}<1722> you.

John 3:1-3 (NKJV) 1 There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." 3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Luke 17:20-21 (NKJV) 20 Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; 21 nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within{έντός}<1787> you."

Matt 23:26 (NKJV) Blind Pharisee, first cleanse the inside{έντός}<1787> of the cup and dish, that the outside of them may be clean also.

Colossians 3:1-4 (NKJV) 1 If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. 3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

### ***No Unrighteousness In Him (The Person)***

John 7:18 (GNT28) ό άφ' έαυτοϋ λαλών την δόξαν την ιδίαν ζητεί· ό δέ ζητών την δόξαν του πέμφαντος αυτόν οϋτος άληθής έστιν και άδικία **έν αύτω** οϋκ έστιν.

John 7:16-18 (NKJV) 16 Jesus answered them and said, "My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me. 17 If anyone wills to do His will, he shall know concerning the doctrine, whether it is from God or whether I speak on My own authority. 18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him{έν αύτω}<1722> <846>."

### ***A Perfect Lamb***

Exodus 12:3-5 (NKJV) 3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: ‘On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household. 4 And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man’s need you shall make your count for the lamb. 5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.

### ***Ruler of this World has Nothing In Me (The Person)***

John 14:30 (GNT28) Οὐκέτι πολλά λαλήσω μεθ’ ὑμῶν, ἔρχεται γὰρ ὁ τοῦ κόσμου ἄρχων· καὶ ἐν ἐμοὶ οὐκ ἔχει οὐδέν,

John 14:30 (NKJV) 30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me{ἐν ἐμοί}<1722> <1473>.

### ***No Fault In Him (The Person)***

Luke 23:3-4 (NKJV) 3 Then Pilate asked Him, saying, “Are You the King of the Jews?” He answered him and said, “It is as you say.” 4 So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, “I find no fault in this Man.”

Luke 23:13-15 (NKJV) 13 Then Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests, the rulers, and the people, 14 said to them, “You have brought this Man to me, as one who misleads the people. And indeed, having examined Him in your presence, I have found no fault in this Man concerning those things of which you accuse Him; 15 no, neither did Herod, for I sent you back to him; and indeed nothing deserving of death has been done by Him.

### ***No Cause for Death In Him (The Person)***

Luke 23:22 (GNT28) ὁ δὲ τρίτον εἶπεν πρὸς αὐτούς· τί γὰρ κακὸν ἐποίησεν οὗτος; οὐδὲν αἴτιον θανάτου εὔρον ἐν αὐτῷ· παιδεύσας οὖν αὐτὸν ἀπολύσω.

Luke 23:22 (NKJV) ¶ Then he said to them the third time, “Why, what evil has He done? I have found no reason for death in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846>. I will therefore chastise Him and let Him go.”

### ***No Fault In Him (The Person)***

John 18:38 (GNT28) λέγει αὐτῷ ὁ Πιλάτος· τί ἐστὶν ἀλήθεια; ¶ Καὶ τοῦτο εἰπὼν πάλιν ἐξῆλθεν πρὸς τοὺς Ἰουδαίους καὶ λέγει αὐτοῖς· ἐγὼ οὐδεμίαν εὕρισκω ἐν αὐτῷ αἰτίαν.

John 18:37-38 (NKJV) 37 Pilate therefore said to Him, “Are You a king then?” Jesus answered, “You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.” 38 Pilate said to Him, “What is truth?” And when he had said this, he went out again to the Jews, and said to them, “I find no fault in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846> at all.

### **No Fault In Him (The Person)**

John 19:4 (GNT28) Καὶ ἐξῆλθεν πάλιν ἔξω ὁ Πιλάτος καὶ λέγει αὐτοῖς· Ἴδε ἄγω ὑμῖν αὐτὸν ἔξω, ἵνα γνῶτε ὅτι οὐδεμίαν αἰτίαν εὐρίσκω **ἐν αὐτῷ**.

John 19:6 (GNT28) ¶ Ὅτε οὖν εἶδον αὐτὸν οἱ ἀρχιερεῖς καὶ οἱ ὑπηρέται ἐκραύγασαν λέγοντες· σταύρωσον σταύρωσον λέγει αὐτοῖς ὁ Πιλάτος· λάβετε αὐτὸν ὑμεῖς καὶ σταυρώσατε· ἐγὼ γὰρ οὐχ εὐρίσκω **ἐν αὐτῷ** αἰτίαν.

John 19:4-6 (NKJV) 4 Pilate then went out again, and said to them, “Behold, I am bringing Him out to you, that you may know that I find no fault in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846>.” 5 Then Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And Pilate said to them, “Behold the Man!” 6 Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, “Crucify Him, crucify Him!” ¶ Pilate said to them, “You take Him and crucify Him, for I find no fault in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846>.”

### **There is No Sin In Him**

1John 3:5 (GNT28) καὶ οἴδατε ὅτι ἐκεῖνος ἐφανερώθη, ἵνα τὰς ἀμαρτίας ἄρῃ, καὶ ἀμαρτία **ἐν αὐτῷ** οὐκ ἔστιν.

1John 3:5 (NKJV) And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846> there is no sin.

### **In Him No Sinning**

1John 3:6 (GNT28) πᾶς ὁ **ἐν αὐτῷ** μένων οὐχ ἀμαρτάνει· πᾶς ὁ ἀμαρτάνων οὐχ ἑώρακεν αὐτὸν οὐδὲ ἔγνωκεν αὐτόν.

1John 3:6 (NKJV) Whoever abides in Him{ἐν αὐτῷ}<1722> <846> does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.

1 John 2:1-2 (NKJV) 1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 2 And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

### **No Condemnation In Christ**

Rom. 8:1 (NA28) ¶ Οὐδὲν ἄρα νῦν κατάκριμα τοῖς **ἐν Χριστῷ** Ἰησοῦ.

Rom. 8:1 (NKJV) There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ{ἐν Χριστῷ}<1722> <5547> Jesus, [who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit].
