

Romans 6:4

“Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.”

Color and cut out the base and both figures.

Fold the base so that the verse reference shows in front and the rest creates a place for the two figures to be taped to. Fold the two figures accordion style and tape the base of the first figure on the platform in front and the base of the second figure immediately behind.

Recite the verse while re-enacting:

Begin with the first figure standing and the second figure folded down to the base. As you read, “Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death...”, lower the first figure onto the base. Continue by raising the second figure as you recite the second part, “...so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.”




Folded Base:



Fold both figures like a fan and tape the 1st figure in front of the 2nd figure on the base.



Begin with the 1st figure extended up and the 2nd figure folded down behind. As you recite the first part of the verse, lower the 1st figure (as if being buried). One student called it a graveyard and drew that on his figure.



Then, as you recite the second part of the verse, raise the 2nd figure up. (Repeat a lot!)
